The High Performance Camp will take place July 22nd-24th, 2011 at the Canada Games Aquatic Centre in Kamloops, British Columbia. The camp will be comprised of practice sessions, scrimmages, and educational sessions. This format allows the coaches to identify aspects of the players' and teams' games that require improvements. They then structure the practices to address these issues. The 2011 Pacific Storm High Performance camp consists of a total of 20 hours of instruction/education as follows:

- 2 hours of recruitment information sessions (open to both parents & athletes)
- 12 hours of practice/skill development pool time
- 6 hours of scrimmages/competitive play

Each team will be head-coached by a U.S. University, Canadian College or Pacific Storm water polo coach. While the framework for the camp is laid out, each coach will bring their own flavour and experience to their teaching.

The overarching aim of the camp is to experience a College/ International Level Program for 3 days. At the conclusion players will know what it takes to play at this high level - having learned and worked closely with some of the best in the business. Our coaches come from some of the best water polo programs in North America as well as some of the finest academic institutions in the World. Players and their parents will also have the opportunity to attend the College Information Seminar, in which our coaches will share their insight and answer all questions about the college recruiting process.

The camp staff is comprised of college coaches, Pacific Storm coaches & alumni.

The coaches have been selected based on their knowledge of the game and coaching reputation. They will challenge each player and help them understand what it takes to play at the next level.

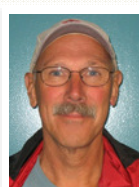
